Project objectives

- To create e-qualifications framework for RU and KZ used for building EQF-based ICT education
- Development of the training system leading to key ICT qualifications
- To establish a network of ICT-training centres in PC universities
- To develop a quality assurance mechanisms ensuring the quality of ICT training
- Dissemination of the System of professional ICT-education, new methodology, teaching materials and methods among ICT-educators and ICT-business



Project stages



- Study of the experience of the ICT qualifications development in European countries
- Training course on ICT qualifications developing for teachers of Russian and Kazakhstani universities
- Development of EQF-based qualifications for ICT profiles
- Development of curricula and tutorials according to the regional requirements
- Preparation of 50 students
- Establishment of the Centre for Additional IT education
